The Lord's Ring was born in the hearts of people who love and desire to serve Jesus Christ.

It was created to be a bold witness of the saving grace of Christ's sacrifice for us.

"I tell you the truth; whoever hears my word and believes him who sent me has eternal life and will not be condemned; he has crossed over from death to life." (John 5:24)

The design was carefully crafted to speak to the wearer and to the one who asks the question, "What does the ring stand for?" The Christian community is the "Bride of Christ" and this ring speaks to the privilege of that relationship.

We belong to Christ. Just as an engagement ring signifies a groom's promise of love, honor and commitment to his bride, this ring symbolizes God's steadfast love for us and our spiritual commitment to Him.

Man was created to spend eternity with God but his sin severed that relationship. The gap in the ring signifies the separation. The cross is the blood sacrifice of Jesus Christ and connects one end of the ring to the other. Christ bridged the gulf created by sin so that we

can now be reunited with Him forever. The precious stone represents Christ's resurrection and our engagement to the bridegroom.

"Let us rejoice and be glad and give him glory! For the wedding of the Lamb has come, and his bride has made herself ready." (Revelation 19:7)

This scripture verse is inscribed on the bottom of the ring to provide a reference to the ring's significance.

The Lord's ring assists in helping to fulfill the Great Commission.

"Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age." (Matthew 28: 19-20)

The Lord's Ring on the hand is a constant reminder of who lives in the heart.
